Eligibility

- Land must be within the WIWCD on private property
- The water body (natural or artificial) must display evidence of severe water erosion and sediment transport
- The WIWCD will cost share at 50% Conservation District to a maximum of \$4,000.00 (plus GST) of the total project cost
- One application per registered landowner per year, dependant on Board approval

Roles and Responsibilities

The Applicant Shall:

1. Applicant must provide a minimum of two (2) quotations for erosion control works to the WIWCD for Board approval
2. Be responsible for required maintenance following the completion of the project and agree to leave the project in place for a minimum of ten (10) years. After ten years, all materials purchased and/or installed will become the property of the landowner
3. Grant consent of entry to the District, its agents, servants, and/or employees with the necessary equipment for inspection and advertisement of the project
4. Provide sufficient room for construction according to improved condition of watercourse
5. Purchase appropriate seed for re-vegetation
6. Not alter, remove, or modify the project without written consent of the District
7. Indemnify and save harmless the WIWCD, their agents, engineers, servants, and/or employees from any liability which may result from this project
8. Allow signage to be placed at project site
9. Be responsible for the remaining 50% and all costs (plus GST) over the Conservation District maximum of \$4,000.00

The WIWCD Shall:

1. Provide technical advice, funding and project supervision
2. Inspect after spring run-off

The annual projects resulting from this program are subject to available annual funding. The Conservation District will determine application priorities in consultation with Sub District members and District staff. All projects must be approved by the Conservation District prior to construction and/or installation.

I hereby declare that I have read and understand the Terms and Conditions of the Riparian Management Program and agree to abide to the said Terms and Conditions if my application is approved and cooperate with the WIWCD in completing and maintaining the project as outlined.
