**Project Description:** The Low Flow Toilet Rebate Program consists of a \$50.00 rebate off the purchase of Low Flow Toilets (also called low flush toilets, dual flush toilets or two-button toilets).

- Toilets must use 6-litres or less of water per flush. Dual flush toilets with a 3 litre and 6 litre flush are preferred.
- Limit of one toilet per household for 2012-2013 year.
- A landowner must fill out an application and receive approval from the West Interlake Watershed Conservation District prior to purchasing the low flow toilet. Once approved for the program, the landowner will receive a coupon for the \$50.00 rebate.
- Toilets must be purchased from an **approved local retail store** that is located within the West Interlake Watershed Conservation District. A list of approved retail stores is below.
- Applications will be assessed on a first-come first-serve basis until program funding runs out.

Toilet must use less than 6 litres of water per flush. Dual flush toilets are preferred. Limit of one per customer / household.

Retailers must present the coupon to WIWCD for reimbursement.

## Low Flow Toilet Rebate Program Criteria

Objective: To conserve water through the replacement from older style toilets (>13 litres of water use per flush) to low flow toilets (<6 litres of water per flush).

### Eligibility and Conditions:

1. A landowner must fill out an application and receive approval from the West Interlake Watershed Conservation District prior to purchasing the low flow toilet. Once approved for the program, the landowner will receive a coupon for the \$50.00 rebate.
2. Toilets must be purchased from an **approved local retail store** that is located within the West Interlake Watershed Conservation District. Approved retail stores are listed on page 1 of this application form.
3. Toilets must be 6-litres or less of water use per flush.
4. Limit of one toilet per household for 2012-2013 year.
5. Applicants are responsible for the proper disposal of the old toilets.
6. Applicants must be in good financial standing with the WIWCD.

The West Interlake Watershed Conservation District:
